## How to get **FREE** Brightside flowers

- ✧ First, talk to your neighbors! Encourage them to participate in a neighborhood clean-up through Blitz.
- ✧ **Register your Blitz clean-up** with Brightside by May 1<sup>st</sup> to become eligible for free flower seedlings.
- ✧ Select your planting area (public spaces only) and recruit neighbors or other volunteers to help plant and maintain the flowers.
- ✧ **Submit a Flower Seedling Request** form to Brightside by May 1<sup>st</sup>.
- ✧ **Pick up your seedlings** from the Greenhouse in Forest Park on May 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup>.

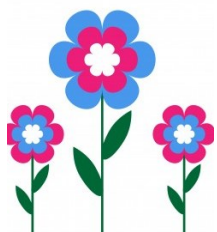
