

It's easy to add beauty to your neighborhood!


- 1. **Get to know your neighbors!** Work together to participate in a neighborhood clean-up through Blitz.
- 2. **Register your Blitz clean-up** with Brightside by April 30th to become eligible for free flower seedlings.
- 3. Select your planting area public property only* and recruit neighbors or other volunteers to help plant and maintain the flowers.
- 4. **Submit a Flower Seedling Request form** to Brightside by April 30th. Chose from two varieties—marigolds and dianthus.
- 5. **Pick up your seedlings** from the Greenhouse in Forest Park on May 4th or 5th.
- 6. **Plant** your neighborhood's seedlings and water regularly.
