

# Blitz Blooms

Register a Blitz clean-up to get  
**FREE flower seedlings**  
to beautify your neighborhood!

1. **Work together!** Organize your neighbors to participate in a Blitz clean-up.
2. **Register your Blitz clean-up** with Brightside by May 1st to become eligible for free flower seedlings.
3. **Select your planting area - public property only\*** - and recruit neighbors or other volunteers to help plant and maintain the flowers.
4. **Submit a Blitz Blooms Flower Seedling Request** online or via mail to Brightside by May 1st. We will have marigolds, dianthus, celosia and vinca.
5. **Pick up your seedlings** from the Greenhouse in Forest Park during designated hours on May 5th or 6th.
6. **Plant** your neighborhood's seedlings and water regularly. Always remove weeds and trash from your garden areas.
7. **Bask in the beauty!**
